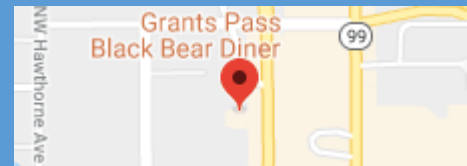

## **RISK/SAFETY MANAGEMENT What is it? Why do it?**
