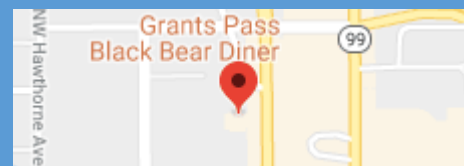

Rikki Perrin is the Education & Outreach Coordinator for Josephine county. She has been working on the Get Ready Rogue Campaign, which focuses on general preparedness. The campaign focuses on “Prep-U”: 7-part trainings which are designed to take each person to their next level of personal preparedness; “Go-Kits”: funded by Friends of Search and Rescue to offer convenient 3-day survival kits to the public at cost; and will eventually include “Beyond the Drill”: helping schools prepare to care for the hundreds of students they would potentially have if an event occurred during school hours; and, “Southern Oregon Seasonal Preparedness”: a program that utilizes local retailers to make seasonal preparedness as simple and convenient as back-to-school shopping. Rikki also presents to a variety of groups, churches, businesses, boards and organizations that requests preparedness trainings.”
